

QUILT CHALLENGE



The guild is sponsoring an interesting and fun challenge. The information and rules are as follows:

1. The size of the piece shall be no larger than 24" x 24"; no smaller than 20" x 20".
2. Any design may be used, but the piece must include a star somewhere in it.
3. Each participant will be given a 5" square of fabric. Some or all of this fabric must be used in the quilt.
4. All techniques or a combination of techniques will be acceptable; i.e. appliqué, embroidery, paper piecing etc.
5. There will be a \$5.00 entry fee for each quilt entered. The entry fee will be used for cash prizes.
6. We will distribute the 5" squares in January 2008. The finished pieces will be on display at the May Banquet. All attendees will be allowed to vote for their favorite and the top three will receive cash prizes—the amount to be determined by number of participants.
7. The pieces will be a part of the September Quilt Show.

Let's all join in the fun - the more pieces, the bigger the prizes. If there are any questions, please call Sherry Wesner or Grace Srbeny.
